## **PARTIES NOT ON PETITIONING CHART**

**Party for Socialism and Liberation (Gloria La Riva)**: Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Iowa, Louisiana, New Jersey, New York, Rhode Island, Utah, Vermont, Washington, and Wisconsin.

**Socialist Workers (Roger Calero)**: Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Iowa, Louisiana, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, Vermont, and Washington.

**Socialist (Brian Moore)**: Colorado, Florida, Iowa, New Jersey, Ohio, Tennessee, Vermont, and Wisconsin.

**America's Independent Party (Alan Keyes)**: on the ballot in Colorado, California, and Florida.

The **Boston Tea Party's** presidential candidate (**Charles Jay**) is on the ballot in Colorado, Florida, and Tennessee.

**Prohibition Party (Gene Amondson)**: On the ballot in Colorado, Florida, and Louisiana.

**Ron Paul** is on the ballot in Louisiana (**Louisiana Taxpayers**) and Montana (**Constitution**).

The **Objectivist Party (Thomas Stevens)** is on in Colorado and Florida.

As far as is known, this list, plus the parties in the petitioning chart above, plus the Democratic and Republican Parties, comprise a complete list of all candidates that are on the ballot in at least two states for president, so far.
